OPINION AND FINDINGS


On February 2, 1999, the Commission entered an Order to Show Cause against Security Transport Services, Omaha, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, in Application B-1478, as to why no action had been taken to proceed with his application. Applicant was ordered to show cause on or before February 26, 1999, why his application should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution. Because applicant failed to respond as ordered by the Commission, the application should be dismissed for lack of prosecution.


