#### OPINION AND FINDINGS

A hearing was held October 14, 2003, on the Commission's Order to Show Cause why the certificate of All Nations Church of the Lord Jesus Christ dba All Nations Specialized Transport and Travel Service (All Nations), Lincoln, Nebraska, should not be revoked for failure to comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission.

At the hearing, All Nations requested further suspension of the Certificate issued in Application No. B-1514. A hearing was held in this matter on October 14, 2003. Mr. Ed Price, owner of All Nations, testified that his company required additional time to construct a bus port for storing company equipment.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted; and the certificate issued to All Nations Church of the Lord Jesus Christ dba All Nations Specialized Transport and Travel Service, Lincoln, in Application No. B-1514 should be suspended until April 1, 2004.
