OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed November 29, 1999, Dwaine A. & Deborah S. Trease dba Special Moments Limousines, Clearwater, Nebraska, seeks approval of a change of ownership status from a corporation to a sole proprietorship in Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity B-1370.

Notice of the application was published in <u>The Daily Record</u>, Omaha, Nebraska, on November 30, 1999, pursuant to the rules of the Commission.

Since no protest was filed, Application B-1515 was processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of the rules of procedure of the Commission.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

- 1. Applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the proposed service.
- 2. The proposed transfer of operating rights will be consistent with the public interest and will not unduly restrict competition.
- 3. The certificate issued in Application B-1370 is not dormant.
- 4. A certificate should be issued in Application B-1515 authorizing the following operations:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

Passengers and their baggage by limousine between points in Hall, Adams, Buffalo, Merrick, Howard, Greeley, York, Hamilton, Dawson, Polk, Nance, Sherman, Valley, Webster, Clay, Nuckolls, Kearney, Harlan and Franklin counties and between points in said counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: No transportation of railroad train crews is authorized.

SUPPLEMENT 1

Passengers and their baggage by limousine between points in Antelope, Furnas, Red Willow, Phelps, Gosper, Frontier, Lincoln, Custer, Thayer, Jefferson, Gage, Fillmore, Saline, Seward, Butler, Platte, Boone, Wheeler, Garfield, Loup, Blaine, Brown, Keya Paha, Rock, Boyd, Knox and Pierce counties and points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: No transportation of railroad train crews is authorized.

SUPPLEMENT 2

Passengers and their baggage by limousine between points in Cedar, Dixon, Dakota, Thurston, Wayne, Madison, Stanton, Cuming, Burt, Colfax, Dodge, Washington, Saunders, Douglas, Sarpy, Lancaster, and Richardson counties and points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: No transportation of railroad train crews is authorized.

5. The certificate issued in Application B-1370 should be revoked and cancelled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED, by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application B-1515 be, and it is hereby, granted; and that upon compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity shall be issued to Dwaine A. & Deborah S. Trease dba Special Moments Limousines, Albion, Nebraska, in Application B-1515, authorizing the operations set forth in the foregoing findings; and that to avoid a lapse in authority, the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued in Application B-1370 shall be revoked and cancelled simultaneously with the issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application B-1515.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall not be issued the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorized by the Commission unless and until applicant has fully complied, within a reasonable time from the effective date of this Order, with Neb. Rev. Stat., Sections 75-305 (fees), 75-307 (insurance), and 75-308 (rates), (Reissue 1996), and with the rules and regulations of the Commission; and if upon expiration of such time applicant has not complied with such terms and conditions, this Order shall, after reasonable notice to applicant, be of no further force and effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall not conduct operations until a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is issued.
