## OPINIONS AND FINDINGS

On June 29, 2000, an order was entered by this Commission granting as amended the application of Marlan V. Dooley d/b/a High Plains Cab (High Plains). In that order, this Commission granted the applicant the authority to provide service as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers by taxicab between points in Red Willow, Hitchcock, Hayes, Dundy, Chase, Frontier, Furnas and Gosper counties and between points within said counties on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes with the restriction that the transportation of railroad train crews was not authorized.

On July 10, 2000, the Protestant in the above-captioned proceeding, R & F Hobbies, Inc. d/b/a Prince of the Road, by and through its attorney, filed a motion for rehearing on our June 29, 2000, order. Oral Argument was held on August 15, 2000 at 11:00 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska. Jack Shultz, P.O. Box 82028, Lincoln, Nebraska, appeared on behalf of High Plains. John Boehm, 811 S. 13<sup>th</sup> Street, Lincoln, Nebraska, appeared on behalf of the protestant. Upon due consideration, we find no reason to change our order. Accordingly, the motion should be denied.
