By application filed August 20, 2001, J.L.R.D., Inc., dba Lincoln Limousine, sought to extend its authority as a common carrier of passengers and their baggage in Nebraska intrastate commerce as described in the caption above.

The Commission finds that the application should be dismissed.


O R D E R


