OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed July 26, 2000, Steven L. Gill dba Cookies Limousine Service, Beatrice, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks approval of the acquisition of the operating rights and authority granted to James L. Cook dba Cookies Limo Service in Certificate B-1482 which authorizes:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

COMMON: Passengers by luxury limousine service between points in Richardson County, and between points within said county on the one hand, and, on the other, points within a 150 mile radius of Falls City over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized.

In its application, applicant further requested that this Commission grant temporary approval to the applicant of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by it. Notice of such request for temporary authority was published in <a href="https://doi.org/10.1001/jhear.10

It appears that failure to grant temporary approval may result in destruction of or injury to such motor carrier property and the certificate sought to be acquired, or interfere substantially with their future usefulness in the performance of adequate and continuous service to the public.

Such temporary approval should be granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat., Section 75-319, (Reissue 1996).

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application for approval of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by Albion Limousine, Inc. be, and it is hereby, granted to the applicant for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that transportation service rendered under such temporary authority shall be subject to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat., Section 75-101 to Section 75-801, (Reissue 1996), and to the rules, regulations and requirements of the Commission; such grant of temporary authority and the operations thereunder shall not be admissible in evidence to establish or prove present or future public convenience and necessity; and no renewal or extension of the period of ninety (90) days shall be granted.
