OPINION AND FINDINGS

On July 31, 2000, International Shuttle Services, Inc., dba ILS Limousine, Bellevue, hereafter referred to as Applicant, filed the above-captioned application.

The application was protested and a hearing set for November 9, 2000. The hearing was continued and reset for January 11, 2001, at the Commission's direction. On January 10, 2001, the attorney for the applicant requested a continuance until a date in mid to late February, 2001. Between the filing of the application and late March 2001, the Applicant changed the tenor of the application. The changes resulted in a conflict of interest, and the representing attorney withdrew. In August and September, 2001, Applicant was contacted via telephone. On both occasions, the Applicant verbally stated that a letter withdrawing its application would be sent to the Commission. As of October 4, 2001, no effort has been made by Applicant to pursue the present application.

After due consideration and fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:
