OPINION AND FINDINGS

By motion filed January 19, 2001, the Protestants Checker Cab Company, Yellow Cab, Happy Cab d/b/a Happy Cab Co. and Don Mark, d/b/a Cornhusker Cab Co., through their undersigned counsel, seek an order compelling the applicant to respond to the Protestant's First Set of Interrogatories. According to the motion, the Protestant's First Set of Interrogatories were served upon the Applicant on or about November 16, 2000, and the applicant has failed to respond to the discovery request.

Upon consideration of this motion and the arguments contained therein, the Commission finds that it should grant the Protestant's Motion to Compel in part. The applicant shall have until February 23, 2001 to serve its answers or objections upon the Protestants.

The Protestants' motion also requests that the Commission award attorney fees to the Protestants. Typically, we do not award attorney's fees to a prevailing movant and we see no justification for doing so in this case. Accordingly, we deny the Protestants' request pertaining to fees.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Protestants' Motion to Compel be, and it is hereby granted in part as described above.
