OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed January 12, 2001, and amended on January 23, 2001, R & J Limo Service, Inc., Cozad, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks approval of the acquisition of a portion of the operating rights and authority granted to Sandhills Limos, Inc., in Certificate B-1372 which authorizes:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

COMMON: Passengers and their baggage by limousine between points in Sioux, Scotts Bluff, Morrill, Box Butte, Dawes and Sheridan counties on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points within a 300-mile radius of Alliance over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. SUPP. 1: Passengers and their baggage between points in and west of Keya Paha, Rock, Loup, Garfield, Valley, Sherman, Buffalo, Kearney, and Franklin counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized.

In its application, applicant further requested that this Commission grant temporary approval to the applicant of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by it. Notice of such request for temporary authority was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 18, 2001, and an amended request for temporary authority on January 24, 2001, pursuant to the rules and regulations of this Commission.

It appears that failure to grant temporary approval may result in destruction of or injury to such motor carrier property and the certificate sought to be acquired, or interfere substantially with their future usefulness in the performance of adequate and continuous service to the public.

Such temporary approval should be granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat., §75-319, (Reissue 1996).

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O R D E R


IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application for approval of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by R & J Limo Service, Inc., be, and it is hereby, granted to the applicant for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that transportation service rendered under such temporary authority shall be subject to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat., §75-101 to §75-801, (Reissue 1996), and to the rules, regulations and requirements of the Commission; such grant of temporary authority and the operations thereunder shall not be admissible in evidence to establish or prove present or future public convenience and necessity; and no renewal or extension of the period of ninety (90) days shall be granted.
