BY THE COMMISSION:

OPINION AND FINDINGS

In its order entered in the matter in caption on April 3, 2001, the authority to be transferred included a restriction which was omitted in error. The order should be modified nunc pro tunc as follows: The transportation of passengers by vans is not authorized.

From the evidence adduced and being fully informed in the premises, the Commission finds that the applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the service proposed and conform with the statutes and rules of the Commission thereunder; and the proposed intrastate service is or will be required by the present or future public convenience and necessity to the following extent:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

COMMON: Transportation of passengers and their baggage by limousine between points in Douglas, Sarpy, Washington, and Lancaster counties, and between points in said counties, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes.

RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. Further restricted to the operation of limousines with a capacity of 12 passengers or more. SUPP. 1: Transportation of passengers by luxury or stretch limousine service in Nebraska intrastate commerce between points in Douglas, Sarpy, Washington and Lancaster Counties over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. The transportation of passengers by vans is not authorized.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission, that its order entered herein April 3, 2001, be, and it is hereby, modified nunc pro tunc to grant the authority set forth in the foregoing findings.
