OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed February 1, 2001, Omaha Limousine, Co., LLC, dba Omaha Limousine, Omaha, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks approval of the acquisition of the operating rights and authority granted to Raymond F. Kurtzuba dba Total Transportation in Certificate B-1500 which authorizes:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

COMMON: Transportation of passengers and their baggage by limousine between points in Douglas, Sarpy, Washington, and Lancaster Counties, and between points in said counties, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes.

RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. Further restricted to the operation of limousines with a capacity of 12 passengers or more. SUPP. 1: Transportation of passengers by luxury or stretch limousine service in Nebraska intrastate commerce between points in Douglas, Sarpy, Washington and Lancaster Counties over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized.

In its application, applicant further requested that this Commission grant temporary approval to the applicant of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by it. Notice of such request for temporary authority was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 5, 2001, pursuant to the rules and regulations of this Commission.

It appears that failure to grant temporary approval may result in destruction of or injury to such motor carrier property and the permit sought to be acquired, or interfere substantially with their future usefulness in the performance of adequate and continuous service to the public.

Such temporary approval should be granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat., Section 75-319 (Reissue 1996).

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application for approval of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by Omaha Limousine Co., LLC, dba Omaha Limousine be, and it is hereby, granted to the applicant for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that transportation service rendered under such temporary authority shall be subject to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat., Section 75-101 and 75-802, (Reissue 1996), and to the rules, regulations and requirements of the Commission; such grant of temporary authority and the operations thereunder shall not be admissible in evidence to establish or prove present or future public convenience and necessity; and no renewal or extension of the period of ninety (90) days shall be granted.
