OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed October 3, 2003, applicant, Omaha Limousine Co., LLC, Omaha, Nebraska, seeking approval of the transfer of minority stock ownership from Mark W. Mitchell and Michael R. Williams to Linus Humpal.

Notice of the application in caption was published in $\frac{\text{The}}{\text{Daily Record}}$ on October 28, 2003, pursuant to the rules of the Commission.

Since no protest was filed, Application B-1548 was processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of the rules of the Commission.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

- 1. That applicant is fit, willing, and able to properly perform the service proposed and will be so qualified after the proposed change in membership is effected.
- 2. That the change in minority member interest resulting from the proposed transfer of stock is consistent with the public interest and does not unduly restrict competition.
- 3. That a change in member interest pursuant to a transfer to Michael R. Williams should be approved.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application B-1548 for approval of a change in minority stock ownership arising out of the transfer of member interest from Mark W. Mitchell and Michael R. Williams to Linus Humpal in Certificate B-1548 be, and it is hereby, approved.
