BEFORE THE NEBRASKA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

In the Matter of Kevin Onken dba APPLICATION NO. B-1560 Barker Cleaners, Sidney, seeking authority as a common carrier of passengers in Nebraska intrastate commerce to provide a limousine service between points in Banner, ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE Chevenne, Deuel, Garden, Kimball, Morrill, and Scotts Bluff counties, and between points in said counties on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train ENTERED: MARCH 19, 2002 crews and their baggage is not authorized.

BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 25, 2001, Kevin Onken dba Barker Cleaners, Sidney, Nebraska, hereafter referred to as applicant, filed an application docketed as Application No. B-1560.

The hearing in this matter was set for December 5, 2001, and was continued at applicant's request in order that applicant may pursue and file a restrictive amendment. No action has been taken since then by the applicant to proceed with the application. Since no action has been taken, the applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before April 19, 2002, why its application should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Kevin Onken dba Barker Cleaners, Sidney, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, ordered to show cause why its application should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution on or before April 19, 2002.
