BEFORE THE NEBRASKA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

In the Matter of Kevin Onken dba APPLICATION NO. B-1560 Barker Cleaners, Sidney, seeking authority as a common carrier of passengers in Nebraska intrastate commerce to provide a limousine service between points in Banner, ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE SUSTAINED Cheyenne, Deuel, Garden, Kimball, AND APPLICATION DISMISSED Morrill, and Scotts Bluff counties, and between points in said counties on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train ENTERED: APRIL 23, 2002 crews and their baggage is not authorized.

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 19, 2002, the Commission entered an Order to Show Cause against Kevin Onken dba Barker Cleaners, Sidney, Nebraska, hereafter referred to as applicant, in Application B-1560 as to why no action had been taken to proceed with his application. Applicant was ordered to show cause on or before April 19, 2002, why his application should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution. Because applicant failed to respond as ordered by the Commission, the application should be dismissed for lack of prosecution.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Order to Show Cause be, and it is hereby, sustained and Application No. B-1560 be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
