OPINION AND FINDINGS

On May 14, 2002, the Commission entered an order requiring Y Turner's Unlimited, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska, to show cause on or before June 14, 2002, why its intrastate registration should not be revoked for failure to file a current Form E insurance and no annual fees have been paid. Because carrier failed to respond as ordered, its intrastate registration should be revoked.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the order to show cause should be sustained and the registration should be revoked.
