## OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed January 30, 2018, Golden Plains Services, LLC, d/b/a High Plains Cab Service ("High Plains"), McCook, seeks to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, which was originally issued by the Commission in Application No. B-1575 on March 7, 2002. The Commission granted High Plains, the authority to provide transportation of passengers by taxicab in sedans, between points in Red Willow, Hitchcock, Hayes, Dundy, Chase, Frontier, Furnas, and Gosper Counties on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. Notice of this application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 2, 2018. No protests were filed, therefore this application shall be processed in accordance with the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted and the authority granted to Golden Plains Services, LLC, d/b/a High Plains Cab Service, Lincoln, Nebraska, in Application No. B-1575 should be cancelled.
