OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed February 22, 2002, Servant Cab Company LLC dba Yellow Cab Company & Capital Cab Company, Lincoln, seeks to acquire, through transfer, the operating rights granted to Husker Cabs Incorporated, in Certificate B-1273.

Notice of the application was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 25, 2002, pursuant to the rules of the Commission.

Because no protests were filed, Application B-1581 was processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of the rules of procedure of the Commission.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

- 1. Applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the proposed extended service.
- The proposed transfer of operating rights will be consistent with the public interest and will not unduly restrict competition.
- 3. The certificate issued in Application B-1273 is not dormant.

4. A certificate should be issued in Application B-1581 authorizing the following operations:

CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZED

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED: Transportation of passengers by taxicab between points in Lincoln and vicinity over irregular routes.

5. The certificate issued in Application B-1273 should be revoked and cancelled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application B-1581 be, and it is hereby, granted; and that upon compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity shall be issued to Servant Cab Company LLC dba Yellow Cab Company and Capital Cab Company, Lincoln, Nebraska, in Application B-1581, authorizing the operations set forth in the foregoing findings; and that to avoid a lapse of authority, the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued in Application B-1273, shall be revoked and cancelled simultaneously with the issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application B-1581.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall not be issued the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorized by the Commission unless and until applicant has fully complied, within a reasonable time from the effective date of this Order, with Neb. Rev. Stat. sections 75-305 (fees), 75-307 (insurance), and 75-308 (rates) (Reissue 1996), and with the rules and regulations of the Commission, and if upon expiration of such time applicant has not complied with such terms and conditions, this Order shall, after reasonable notice to applicant, be of no further force and effect.
