BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On January 25, 2011, an application was filed by Servant Cab Company d/b/a Yellow Cab Company and Capital Cab Company, Lincoln, Nebraska, seeking to extend its authority by adding Supplement 1 as follows: The transportation of passengers and their baggage in Nebraska intrastate commerce between points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTIONS: The transportation of passengers and their baggage by taxicab originating from or point-to-point within any territory where a taxicab holds a certificate or permit, except Douglas, Sarpy, and Washington counties, is not authorized. Transportation of railroad train crews: Yes. HHS Designation: Yes. Protests were timely filed by Happy Cab Company d/b/a Checker Cab Company, DonMark, Inc. d/b/a Cornhusker Cab Company, Happy Cab Company d/b/a Yellow Cab Company, Happy Cab Company d/b/a Happy Cab Company, and by Valor Transportation Company d/b/a Safeway Cab, by their attorney, Andy S. Pollock; Armadillo Express by its attorney, Brad Kistler; Yellow Cab and Limo, Beatrice, Nebraska; and High Plains Cab Service, McCook, Nebraska.

In order to process the application, the Commission held a planning conference in this matter on March 27, 2012, at 11:00 a.m. via telephone conference with the applicant and counsel for the represented protestants. The following persons were present at the conference: Commissioner Rod Johnson, Hearing Officer; Jack Shultz, attorney the applicant; Andy Pollock, attorney for

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the protestant cab companies; Seth Felton, attorney for Brown's Crew Car; Ron Hippen, Yellow Cab and Taxi, Beatrice; Marlon Dooley, High Plains Cabs, McCook; and Mark Breiner, staff attorney.

As a result of the planning conference, several issues were decided. Therefore, this order serves to memorialize those decisions and to provide a timeline for proceeding in this docket.

Deadline	Event
April 20, 2012	All written discovery served. Supplemental written discovery may be served by the parties after this date as agreed by the parties.
May 11, 2012	Answers to Interrogatories and Responses to Request for Production and Responses to Request for Admissions are due.
May 23, 2012	All depositions completed. If parties seek to settle, settlement achieved, and Commission notified to cancel hearing. Hearings canceled after this date are subject to applicable hearing fee.
June 12, 2012	Any stipulations and exhibits must be exchanged by the parties and filed with the Commission. Final witness lists exchanged by parties and filed with the Commission. Any requests for subpoenas shall be filed in writing with the Commission. No requests for subpoenas will be accepted after this date.
June 15, 2012	Any requests for a continuation or cancellation of a video conference hearing must be made to the Commission at least 48 hours prior to the start of the hearing. The party failing to give timely notification will be responsible for payment of all charges incurred

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as a result of improper notification. All fees incurred must be paid before future hearings will be scheduled.

Finally, the hearing in Application No. B-1581, Supplement 1, will be held on **June 19, 2012**, at **1:30 p.m.**, **June 20, 2012**, at **9:00 a.m.**, and on **June 21, 2012**, at **9:00 a.m.**, at the State Office Building, 1313 Farnam Street, Omaha, Nebraska, and in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska

Any remaining pre-hearing issues that the parties would like to address should be brought before the Commission prior to hearing.
