OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed July 5, 2002, Alford Oil Company dba Embassy Limo, Omaha, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks approval of the acquisition of the operating rights and authority granted to Embassy Limousine, Inc., in Certificate B-1392 which authorizes:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

Transportation of passengers and their baggage by luxury sedan limousines between points in Washington, Sarpy, Douglas, and Cass counties. SUPP. 1: Passengers and their baggage by luxury sedan, limousine, and passenger vans between points in Nebraska.

In its application, applicant further requested that this Commission grant temporary approval to the applicant of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by it. Notice of such request for temporary authority was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 9, 2002, pursuant to the rules and regulations of this Commission.

It appears that failure to grant temporary approval may result in destruction of or injury to such motor carrier property and the certificate sought to be acquired, or interfere substantially with their future usefulness in the performance of adequate and continuous service to the public. Such temporary approval should be granted, pending final resolution of this application, for no more than ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. section 75-319 (Reissue 1996). Temporary authority should expire immediately upon the Commission's final resolution of this application.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application for approval of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by Alford Oil Company dba Embassy Limo, Omaha, will, and it is hereby, granted to the applicant for no more than ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that such temporary authority expires immediately upon the Commission's final resolution of this application.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that transportation service rendered under such temporary authority shall be subject to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. (Reissue 1996), section 75-311, and to the rules, regulations and requirements of the Commission; such grant of temporary authority and the operations thereunder shall not be admissible in evidence to establish or prove present or future public convenience and necessity; and no renewal or extension of the period of no more than ninety (90) days shall be granted.
