OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed February 7, 2003, Alford Oil Company dba VIP Limousine, Omaha, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks approval of the acquisition of the operating rights and authority granted to VIP Specialists, Lincoln, in Certificate B-1563 which authorizes:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

Transportation of passengers in Nebraska intrastate commerce in open class service by 12 to 14 passenger bus between points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. The transportation of passengers by limousine is not authorized. The picking up and/or discharging of passengers in Douglas and Sarpy counties (other than as part of round trips which both originate and terminate outside of Douglas and Sarpy Counties) is not authorized. SUPP. 1: Transportation of passengers in limousine service bus in Nebraska intrastate commerce between points in Nebraska over irregular routes.

In its application, applicant further requested that this Commission grant temporary approval to the applicant of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by it. Notice of such request for temporary authority was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 13, 2003, pursuant to the rules and regulations of this Commission.

It appears that failure to grant temporary approval may result in destruction of or injury to such motor carrier property and the certificate sought to be acquired, or interfere substantially with their future usefulness in the performance of adequate and continuous service to the public.

Such temporary approval should be granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. (Reissue 1996), section 75-319.

O R D E R


IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application for approval of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by Alford Oil Company dba VIP Limousine, will, and it is hereby, granted to the applicant for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that transportation service rendered under such temporary authority shall be subject to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. (Reissue 1996), section 75-311, and to the rules, regulations and requirements of the Commission; such grant of temporary authority and the operations thereunder shall not be admissible in evidence to establish or prove present or future public convenience and necessity; and no renewal or extension of the period of ninety (90) days shall be granted.
