By order of the Commission entered January 22, 2003, Marshanette Booker & Sons dba Safe Senior Transportation Services, (S.S.T.S.), Omaha, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, was granted authority as a common carrier of passengers in Application B-1595.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

As of April 29, 2003, applicant is still not in full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations; to wit: No Form E insurance filing has been made and no annual fees have been paid.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before May 29, 2003, why its authority should not be revoked for its failure to comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission.




O R D E R
