BY THE COMMISSION:

By show cause order entered April 29, 2003, and modified on May 23, 2003, the Commission ordered Marshanette Booker & Sons dba Safe Senior Transportation Services, (hereinafter, "applicant") of Omaha, Nebraska, to demonstrate why the authority granted in Application B-1595 should not be revoked for failure to comply with Commission rules and the order entered in Application B-1595. A hearing on the matter was held on July 8, 2003, in the Commission Hearing Room. The applicant's counsel entered an appearance as shown above.

In its May 23, 2003, Order, the Commission ordered that Marshanette Booker & Sons dba Safe Senior Transportation Services had until July 8, 2003, to file Form E insurance and pay annual fees. As of July 8, 2003, applicant has not complied with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission.
