BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On November 12, 2002, an application was filed by Judy Mohler dba Cruising with "Care", seeking authority as a passenger carrier pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. Section 75-310. Protests were timely filed by Comstock Corporation dba Action Cab, Prince of the Road, Servant Cab Company and A-1 Ambassador Limousine, Inc., dba Special Services.

In order to process the application, a planning conference was held in this matter on June 25, 2003, at 9 a.m. at the Commission, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska. The following persons were present at the conference: Michael Burns representing Judy Mohler dba Cruising with Care, John Boehm representing Prince of the Road, Brad Kistler representing Action Cab and Elaine Waggoner representing A-1 Ambassador Limousine.

As a result of the planning conference, several issues were decided. Therefore, this order serves to memorialize those decisions and to provide a timeline for proceeding in this docket.

Any stipulations and exhibits must be exchanged by the parties and filed with the Commission. Final witness lists exchanged by parties and filed with the Commission. Any requests for subpoenas shall be filed in writing with the Commission. No requests for subpoenas will be accepted after this date.

Any requests for a continuation or cancellation of a video conference hearing must be made to the Commission at least 48 hours prior to the start of the hearing. The party failing to give timely notification will be responsible for payment of all charges incurred as a result of improper notification. All fees incurred must be paid before future hearings will be scheduled.

Finally, the hearing in Application No. B-1609 will be held on August 20, 2003, at 9 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Library, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska and via video conference at the following sites: Hastings Library, 517 W. 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Hastings, Nebraska, 69101.

A hearing fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each half day of hearing will be charged to the applicant payable upon billing from the Executive Director of the Public Service Commission (Neb. Rev. Stat. §75-128, Cum. Supp. 1995).
