OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed with the Commission on November 18, 2002, Angel Vazquez dba El Aguila Transportation, Lexington, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, was issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application B-1611. An order was entered, at applicant's request, on November 4, 2003, granting an extension of time until December 15, 2003, to comply with the rules and regulations of the Commission.

As of January 6, 2004, applicant is still not in full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations; to wit: No Form E insurance filing has been made, no annual fees have been paid, and no rates have been filed.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before February 12, 2004, why its certificate should not be revoked for its failure to comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Angel Vazquez dba El Aguila Transportation, Lexington, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby ordered to show cause why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked for failure to comply with Commission rules on or before February 12, 2004, and a hearing was set for February 12, 2004, at 9:30 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln.
