OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed with the Commission on December 11, 2002, Rick Holloway dba Taxi Specialties of Lexington, Lexington, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as Specialties, was issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application B-1613.

On September 13, 2006, Rick Holloway dba Taxi Specialties of Lexington, Nebraska, was ticketed for driving under the influence and was incarcerated.

On September 14, 2006, Mr. Holloway pled guilty on charges of no PSC cards/plates and no insurance. He was fined \$100 on each count and \$44 court costs.

Specialties was not operating on September 7 and 8, 2006, and was not taking calls or providing services on those dates.

Also, Motor Carrier Rules and Regulations state that a carrier must have viable insurance on file with the Commission. The current Form E canceled on September 19, 2006, and there is no replacement insurance on file.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before September 22, 2006, why its certificate should not be revoked or the authority holder fined for its failure to comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Rick Holloway dba Taxi Specialties of Lexington, Lexington, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby ordered to show cause why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked or the authority holder fined for failure to comply with Commission rules on or before September 22, 2006, and a hearing was set for September 25, 2006, at 1:30 p.m. in the Commission Library, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska, and Educational Service Unit #16, 1221 W. 17<sup>th</sup> Street, Distance Learning Room, North Platte, Nebraska.
