## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On December 13, 2002, in Application No. B-1614, the Commission granted as amended the application of Corn Belt Travel, Inc., dba First Place Travel/Bye Bye Now Limousine of Sioux City, Iowa, hereafter referred to as applicant. Said authorization was subject to the terms and conditions provided in the Commission's Order. Applicant was given 90 days to comply with the terms and conditions in the order and the Commission's rules and regulations.

As of November 13, 2003, Applicant is not in compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations; to wit: No Form E insurance filing has been made, no annual fees have been paid, and no rates have been filed.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before December 15, 2003, why its authorization should not be revoked for its failure to comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission.

## ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Corn Belt Travel, Inc., dba First Place Travel/Bye Bye Now Limousine, Sioux City, Iowa, be, and it is hereby ordered to show cause why the authorization granted in the B-1614 order should not be revoked for failure to comply with a Commission rule and its order on or before December 15, 2003, and a hearing was set for December 15, 2003, at 1:30 p.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln.
