## OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed with the Commission on March 3, 2013, Kincaid Coach Lines, Edwardsville, Kansas, hereinafter referred to as Applicant, was issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application B-1619. An order was entered, at Applicant's request, on March 12, 2012, suspending Applicant's certificate until March 1, 2013. Applicant was informed that its authority is no longer in suspension and that it must make full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations.

As of April 9, 2013, Applicant is still not in full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations; to wit: No annual fees have been paid.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that Applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before April 19, 2013, why its certificate should not be revoked for its failure to comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission.

## ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Kincaid Coach Lines, Inc., Edwdardsville, Kansas, be, and it is hereby ordered to show cause why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked for failure to comply with Commission rules on or before April 19, 2013, and a hearing was set for April 30, 2013, at 11:00 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln.
