BY THE COMMISSION:

By show cause order entered April 9, 2013, this Commission ordered Kincaid Coach Lines, Inc., of Edwardsville, Kansas, to demonstrate why its certificate of public convenience and necessity should not be revoked. A hearing on the matter was held on April 30, 2013, in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska. Kincaid Coach Lines did not enter an appearance at the hearing. Mark Breiner appeared on behalf of the Commission staff.

On March 13, 2013, Kincaid Coach Lines filed for a suspension of their authority until March 1, 2013. The application for suspension was granted on March 20, 2012. The suspension expired on March 1, 2013. Kincaid Coach Lines was contacted regarding their intentions for the certificate. Kincaid Coach Lines did not inform the Commission of their plans for the certificate.




As of April 30, 2013, the Applicant is still not in full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations; to wit: No annual fees have been paid. The Commission finds that the authority granted to Kincaid Coach Lines should be revoked for its failure to be in compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations.

O P I N I O N S A N D F I N D I N G S

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the authority granted to Kincaid Coach Lines, Inc., in B-1619, shall be, and it is hereby, revoked.
