OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed March 3, 2003, Kincaid Coach Lines, Inc., Edwardsville, Kansas, seeks to acquire, through transfer, the operating rights granted to Good Life Transportation, Lincoln, Nebraska, in Certificate B-1447.

No protests were filed to this application. Application B-1619 was then processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of the rules of procedure of the Commission.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

- 1. Applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the proposed extended service.
- 2. The proposed transfer of operating rights will be consistent with the public interest and will not unduly restrict competition.
- 3. The Certificate issued in Application B-1447 is not dormant.
- 4. A Certificate should be issued in Application B-1619 authorizing the following operations:

CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZED

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

COMMON: Bus service in the transportation of passengers in a special party and charter bus operation between points within a 150 mile radius of Lincoln and points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTIONS: All bus operations must originate and terminate within a 250 mile radius of Lincoln, and the transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. CONTRACT: Passengers by bus between points in Lancaster County over regular and irregular Routes under continuing contract(s). RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized.

The certificate issued in Application B-1447 should be revoked and cancelled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application B-1619, be, and it is hereby, granted; and that upon compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity shall be issued to Kincaid Coach Lines, Inc., in Application B-1619 authorizing the operations set forth in the foregoing findings; and that to avoid a lapse of authority, the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued in Application B-1447, shall be revoked and cancelled simultaneously with the issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application B-1619.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall not be issued the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorized by the Commission unless and until applicant has fully complied, within a reasonable time from the effective date of this Order, with Neb. Rev. Stat., sections 75-305 (fees), 75-307 (insurance), and 75-308 (rates), (Reissue 1996), and within the rules and regulations of the Commission, and if upon expiration of such time applicant has not complied with such terms and conditions, this Order shall reasonable notice to applicant, be of no further force and effect.
