On February 9, 2012, an application was filed with the Nebraska Public Service Commission by OMALiNK, LLC, Lincoln, Nebraska, seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers by taxi within a 100 mile radius of Lincoln, Nebraska, over irregular routes. HHS Designation: No. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized.
