BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On May 29, 2003, an application was filed by Danny L. McMullen, d/b/a Personal Touch Limousine Service, of Grand Island, Nebraska, seeking authority as a passenger carrier pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. Section 75-310. Protests were timely filed by R & F Hobbies, Inc. d/b/a Prince of the Road ["Prince of the Road"] on June 9, 2003, and by Yellow Cab & Limo on June 11, 2003.

In order to process the application, the Commission held a planning conference in this matter on July 14, 2003, at 10:00 a.m. at the Commission Library, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska and via telephone conference with the Applicant and Protestant Prince of the Road. The following persons were present at the conference and via telephone: Commissioner Lowell Johnson; Shana Knutson attorney for the Commission; Danny McMullen, the applicant; and John Boehm, attorney for Prince of the Road.

As a result of the planning conference, several issues were decided. Therefore, this order serves to memorialize those decisions and to provide a timeline for proceeding in this docket.

Any stipulations and exhibits must be exchanged by the parties and filed with the Commission. Final witness lists exchanged by the parties and filed with the Commission. Any requests for subpoenas shall be filed in writing with the Commission. No requests for subpoenas will be accepted after this date.

Finally, the hearing in Application No. B-1630 will be held on October 22, 2003, at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room located at 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska.

Any remaining issues that the parties would like to address should be brought before the Commission prior to hearing.
