O R D E R



IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that applicant's motion to dismiss without prejudice be, and it is hereby, granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Application B-1630, be, and it is hereby, dismissed without prejudice at applicant's request.


