By Motion to Compel or Otherwise Authorize Answers to Discovery filed April 27, 2004, the Protestant Omaha Limousine Co., LLC (movant) through its undersigned counsel requests an order compelling the applicant to answer Interrogatory No. 12 in the Interrogatories and Request for Production of Documents served on or about February 27, 2004. The movant also requests the authorization of additional interrogatories 15 through 29. In support of its Motion, the movant states that the answer to Interrogatory Nos. 12, and 15 through 29 are critical to the preparation of the Protestant's case.

Upon consideration of this Motion, the Hearing Officer is of the opinion and finds that Applicant should be required to answer Interrogatory No. 12. The applicant should further respond to supplemental Interrogatory Nos. 21, 23, and 25. Applicant shall have until May 10, 2004 to respond to such discovery.
