OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed May 17, 2004, by AmeriStar Tours, LLC, Scottsbluff, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks approval of the acquisition of the operating rights and authority granted to Donald D. Reichert dba Good Tyme Charter, , in Certificate B-1308 which authorizes:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED: COMMON: Transportation of passengers and their baggage by bus in charter and special party operations between points in Nebraska over irregular routes.

In its application, applicant further requested that this Commission grant temporary approval to the applicant of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by it. Notice of such request for temporary authority was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 28, 2004, pursuant to the rules and regulations of this Commission.

It appears that failure to grant temporary approval may result in destruction of or injury to such motor carrier property and the certificate sought to be acquired, or interfere substantially with their future usefulness in the performance of adequate and continuous service to the public.

Such temporary approval should be granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. (Reissue 1996), section 75-319.
