OPINION AND FINDINGS

On July 8, 2004, Juvenile Re-entry Community Program, Inc., dba Community Van Services, Omaha, hereafter referred to as applicant, filed an application docketed as Application B-1653. Several attempts have been made to expedite prosecution of the application with no success.

On March 13, 2007, the Commission entered a Pending Dismissal Order that gave the Applicant until March 30, 2007, to contact the Commission to set a hearing date for the application or that the application would be dismissed. That deadline passed with no contact from the Applicant.
