OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed December 9, 2005, Alford Oil Company dba Omaha Limousine, Omaha, Nebraska, Omaha, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks approval of the acquisition of the operating rights and authority granted to Omaha Limousine Co., LLC, dba Omaha Limousine in Certificate B-1548 which authorizes:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

COMMON: Transportation of passengers and their baggage by limousine between points in Douglas, Sarpy, Washington, and Lancaster counties, and between points in said counties, and on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. Further restricted to the operation of limousines with a capacity of 12 passengers ore SUPP. 1: Transportation of passengers by luxury or stretch limousine service in Nebraska intrastate commerce between points in Douglas, Sarpy, Washington and Lancaster counties over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. SUPP. 2: Transportation of passengers in limousine service by vans will be limited to prearranged service only and not for service to the general public on a demand basis. The governmentally financed transportation of clients of the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services and/or clients of private contractors of the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services and/or persons in the custody of the Nebraska Department of Corrections and/or students on behalf of schools by van is not authorized.

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In its application, applicant further requested that this Commission grant temporary approval to the applicant of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by it. Notice of such request for temporary authority was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 7, 2005, pursuant to the rules and regulations of this Commission.

It appears that failure to grant temporary approval may result in destruction of or injury to such motor carrier property and the certificate sought to be acquired, or interfere substantially with their future usefulness in the performance of adequate and continuous service to the public.

Such temporary approval should be granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. (Reissue 1996), section 75-319.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application for approval of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by Alford Oil Company dba Omaha Limousine, Omaha, will, and it is hereby, granted to the applicant for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that transportation service rendered under such temporary authority shall be subject to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. (Reissue 2003), section 75-311, and to the rules, regulations and requirements of the Commission; such grant of temporary authority and the operations thereunder shall not be admissible in evidence to establish or prove present or future public convenience and necessity; and no renewal of extension of the period of ninety (90) days shall be granted.
