O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

On October 24, 2005, On the Clock Taxi, Lincoln, filed an application for intrastate motor carrier authority.

On June 4, 2007, a subsequent application was filed replacing B-1674 docketed as B-1703. On March 24, 2009, B-1703 was dismissed for lack of prosecution. A letter was sent to applicant requesting his intentions as far as prosecuting B-1674 requesting a reply. After due consideration and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the applicant should contact the Commission immediately to schedule a hearing if the applicant desires to proceed with the application. If the applicant does not contact the Commission on or before July 3, 2009, to set a hearing date, the application will be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the above-captioned application shall be dismissed unless applicant has contacted the Commission as directed herein.
