## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 24, 2005, On the Clock Taxi, Lincoln, filed an application for intrastate motor carrier authority.

On June 4, 2007, a subsequent application was filed replacing B-1674 docketed as B-1703. On March 24, 2009, B-1703 was dismissed for lack of prosecution. A letter was sent to applicant requesting his intentions as far as prosecuting B-1674 requesting a reply by April 6, 2009. On June 23, 2009, an order for pending dismissal was entered giving the applicant until July 3, 2009, to respond. As of July 7, 2009, there has been no reply from the applicant. After due consideration and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be dismissed.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the above-captioned application shall be dismissed.
