OPINION AND FINDINGS

As of September 28, 2010, applicant is still not in full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations; to wit: No Form E insurance filing has been made and no yearly fees have been paid.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before October 8, 2010, why its certificate should not be revoked for its failure to comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Taxi Specialties of Lexington, LLC, dba Lexington Taxi, Lexington, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby ordered to show cause why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked for failure to comply with Commission rules on or before October 8, 2010, and a hearing was set for October 13, 2010, at 1:30 p.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln.
