OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed August 31, 2007, Lock P.C. dba Orr Psychotherapy Resources, Lincoln, hereafter referred to as applicant, seeks a Permit to operate as a common carrier of passengers by motor vehicle as follows:

AUTHORITY SOUGHT

Transportation of clients of Orr Psychotherapy Resources and their baggage between points within 30 miles of current Orr Psychotherapy Resources offices in Lancaster and Seward Counties in open class service by van over irregular routes
RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized.

Notice of the application was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 5, 2007, pursuant to the rules of the Commission.

On September 20, 2007, a protest was filed by Yellow Cab & Limo, Inc., Beatrice. On October 12, 2007, the protest was withdrawn. Application B-1707 was then processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of the rules of procedure of the Commission.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. Applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the proposed service, and to conform to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat., sections 75-301 to 75-322.04, (Reissue 2003), and the requirements, rules and regulations of the Commission thereunder.
2. The proposed intrastate service is or will be required by the following extent:

PERMIT AUTHORIZED

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

Transportation of clients of Orr Psychotherapy Resources and their baggage between points within 30 miles of current Orr Psychotherapy Resources offices in Lancaster and Seward Counties in open class service by van over irregular routes
RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized.

3. The application for authority should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application B-1707 be, and it is hereby, granted; and that upon compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, a Permit shall be issued to Lock P.C. dba Psychotherapy Resources, Lincoln, Nebraska, in Application B-1707.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall not be issued the Permit authorized by the Commission unless and until applicant has fully complied, within a reasonable time from the effective date of this Order, with Neb. Rev. Stat. sections 75-305 (fees), 75-307 (insurance), and 75-308 (rates) (Reissue 2003), and with the rules and regulations of the Commission, and if upon expiration of such time applicant has not complied with such terms and conditions, this Order shall, after reasonable notice to applicant, be of no further force and effect.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall not conduct operations until a Permit is issued.
