OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed April 29, 2015, Leisure Limousine & Sedan, Inc., Lincoln, seeks to change an existing operation by the transfer of stock ownership.

Notice of the application was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 4, 2015, pursuant to the rules of the Commission.

Because no protests were filed, Application B-1718 was processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of the rules of procedure of the Commission.

Leisure Limousine & Sedan, Inc., is a corporation duly organized and existing under and by the virtue of the laws of the state of Nebraska, with its principal place of business being in Lincoln, Nebraska. The business headquarters of Leisure Limousine & Sedan, Lincoln, Nebraska, will remain in its current location in Lincoln, Nebraska, if the transfer of the stock of Leisure Limousine & Sedan is approved by the Commission. Applicant is in the business of providing transportation services in Douglas, Sarpy, Lancaster, Washington, York and Gage counties by limousine. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No. The Applicant will continue to provide the same service.

As the matter was not protested, it proceeded on a modified basis.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. Applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the proposed extended service.
2. The proposed change of control will be consistent with the public interest and will not unduly restrict competition.
3. The certificate issued in Application B-1718 is not dormant.
4. An order should be entered in Application B-1718 authorizing Leisure Limousine & Sedan, Inc., Lincoln, to change an existing operation by the transfer of stock ownership.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application B-1718, be, and it is hereby, granted; and that Leisure Limousine & Sedan, Inc., Lincoln, is hereby authorized to change its existing operation by the transfer of stock ownership as follows: Current ownership: Lori J. Hiebner (25%), Margaret A. Merchant (25%), Jeffrey D. Merchant (25%), Lyndon D. Hiebner (25%).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the operations authorized herein shall be subject to the terms, conditions, and imitations which have been, or may hereafter be prescribed by the Commission.
