OPINION AND FINDINGS

On March 13, 2009, Shera Clift, Omaha, filed an application for intrastate motor carrier authority. On May 27, 2009, a letter was sent to applicant giving them until June 15, 2009, to contact the Commission with their intentions.

If the applicant does not contact the Commission on or before July 7, 2009, to set a hearing date, the application will be dismissed.
