OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed February 16, 2017, Pristine Limousine, LLC ("Applicant"), North Platte, informed the Commission that it wished to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in Application No. B-1741 on June 23, 2009. The Commission granted Applicant the authority to provide transportation of passengers by limousine between points in Red Willow, Chase, Dawson, Dundy, Frontier, Furnas, Gosper, Hayes Keith, Lincoln, and Perkins Counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews was not authorized. Notice of this application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 20, 2017. No protests were filed.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted and the authority granted to Pristine Limousine, LLC, North Platte, in Application No. B-1741 should be cancelled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application of Pristine Limousine, LLC is hereby granted and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued in B-1741 is hereby cancelled.
