OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed July 1, 2009, Terry L. Blakey Enterprises, LLC, Omaha, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks approval of the acquisition of the operating rights and authority granted to Prime Consultants, Inc., dba Goodwill Medical Transportation in Certificate B-1555.

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:
COMMON: The transportation of passengers by van in open
class between points in Cass, Douglas, Sarpy, and Washington
counties over irregular routes. HHS Designation: Yes.
RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and
their baggage is not authorized.
