OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed January 6, 2010, O.U.R. Homes, Lincoln, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks a Permit to operate as a contract carrier of passengers by motor vehicle as follows:

AUTHORITY SOUGHT

Transportation of clientele of O.U.R. Homes and their baggage by buses and vans in Lancaster County, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: Yes.

Notice of the application was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 18, 2010, pursuant to the rules of the Commission.

On January 29, 2010, a protest was filed by Servant Cab Company through their attorney, Jack Shultz. On March 4, 2010, the protest was withdrawn. Application B-1750 was then processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of the rules of procedure of the Commission.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. Applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the proposed service, and to conform to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat., sections 75-301 to 75-322.04, (Reissue 2003), and the requirements, rules and regulations of the Commission thereunder.
2. The proposed intrastate service is or will be required by the following extent:

PERMIT AUTHORIZED

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

Transportation of clientele of O.U.R. Homes, Lincoln, and their baggage by buses and vans between points in Lancaster County and between points in Lancaster County, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: Yes.

3. The application for authority should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application B-1750 be, and it is hereby, granted; and that upon compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, a Permit shall be issued to O.U.R. Homes, Lincoln, Nebraska, in Application B-1750.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall not be issued the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorized by the Commission unless and until applicant has fully complied, within a reasonable time from the effective date of this Order, with Neb. Rev. Stat. sections 75-305 (fees), 75-307 (insurance), and 75-308 (rates) (Reissue 2003), and with the rules and regulations of the Commission, and if upon expiration of such time applicant has not complied with such terms and conditions, this Order shall, after reasonable notice to applicant, be of no further force and effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall not conduct operations until a Permit issued.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the operations authorized herein shall be subject to the terms, conditions, and limitations which have been, or may hereafter be prescribed by the Commission.
