OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed May 16, 2016, Night Life Limousine, LLC, ("Night Life" or "Applicant"), Beatrice, seeks to change an existing operation by sale or transfer of stock ownership. Applicant proposes to change its existing stock ownership as follows: Current ownership, Joseph Armstrong (50%) and Erich Tiemann (50%); Proposed ownership, Melissa Shandera (50%) and Jeremy Snyder (50%).

Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 19, 2016, pursuant to the rules of the Commission. Temporary operating authority was granted by the Commission on June 16, 2016.

Night Life Limousine is an LLC duly organized and existing under and by the virtue of the laws of the State of Nebraska, with its principal place of business being in Beatrice, Nebraska. The business headquarters of Night Life will remain in in Beatrice, Nebraska, if the transfer of the stock of Night Life Limousine is approved by the Commission. Night Life is in the business of providing transportation of passengers by limousine and holds the following authorization:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED: Transportation of passengers and their baggage in limousine service over irregular routes between points in Gage and Jefferson counties. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No.

SUPPLEMENT 1:

Transportation of passengers by limousine in Gage, Jefferson, Johnson, Pawnee, Saline, Fillmore, Thayer, Otoe, Nemaha, Richardson, Seward, York, Clay, Nuckolls, Adams and Webster counties, on the one hand, and on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews

and their baggage is not authorized. SUPPLEMENT 3:

Transportation of passengers and their baggage in Nebraska intrastate commerce to provide limousine service in sedan and luxury or stretch limousines between points in Douglas, Sarpy, Lancaster and Washington counties over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No.

SUPPLEMENT 4:

Transportation of passengers and their baggage by bus in charter and special party service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No.

Applicant will continue to provide the same service. Because no protests were filed, Application No. B-1757 was processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of Commission Rules of Procedure.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

- 1. Applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the proposed service.
- 2. The proposed change of control will be consistent with the public interest and will not unduly restrict competition.
- 3. The certificate issued in Application No. B-1757 is not dormant.
- 4. An order should be entered in Application No. B-1757 authorizing Night Life Limousine, LLC, Beatrice, to transfer stock ownership.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. B-1757 be, and it is hereby, granted; and that Night Life Limousine, LLC, Beatrice, is hereby authorized to change its existing stock ownership as follows: Current ownership, Joseph Armstrong (50%) and Erich Tiemann (50%); Approved ownership, Melissa Shandera (50%) and Jeremy Snyder (50%).
