OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed March 2, 2010, Kravek, LLC, dba Aquila Limo Service, Grand Island, seeks to acquire, through transfer, the operating rights granted to R & F Hobbies, Inc., dba Aquila Limo Service, in Certificate B-1697.

Notice of the application was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 11, 2010, pursuant to the rules of the Commission.

A protest was filed on March 16, 2010, by Special Moments On April 12, 2010, its protest was withdrawn. Application B-1758 was processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of the rules of procedure of the Commission.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

- Applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform 1. the proposed extended service.
- The proposed transfer of operating rights will be 2. consistent with the public interest and will not unduly restrict competition.
- The certificate issued in Application B-1697 is not 3. dormant.
- A certificate should be issued in Application B-1758 4. authorizing the following operations:

CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZED

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

COMMON: Transportation of passengers by limousine between points in Sherman, Buffalo, Custer, Garfield, Hall and Howard counties and between points within said counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: No transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage or transportation originating in Hall County is authorized. Supp. A: Transportation of passengers and their baggage by limousine between points in Loup, Blaine, Wheeler, Valley, Greeley, Hamilton, Kearney, and Phelps counties and between points within said counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Lancaster County over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. Supp. B: Transportation of passengers and their baggage by luxury limousine between points in Adams, Webster, Clay and Hall counties over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. Supp C: Transportation of passengers by luxury limousine between points in Chase, Dundy, Hayes, Hitchcock, Frontier, Red Willow, Furnas, Gosper, Dawson, Harlan, Franklin, Nuckolls, Holt, Knox, Antelope, Boone, Nance and Merrick counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: (1) Transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized; (2) Transportation of passengers in vehicles other than sedan-style luxury limousine is not authorized; (3) governmentally financed transportation of clients of the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services and/or of private contractors of the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, such as, but not limited to, FHC Options, Partners, and Curtis & Associates, and/or persons in the custody of the Nebraska Department of Corrections, in capacity as such clients and/or persons in custody is not authorized.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application B-1758, be, and it is hereby, granted; and that upon compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity shall be issued to Kravek, LLC, dba Aquila Limo Service, Grand Island, Nebraska, in Application B-1758, authorizing the operations set forth in the foregoing findings; and that to avoid a lapse of authority, the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued in Application B-1697, shall be revoked and cancelled simultaneously with the issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application B-1758.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall not be issued the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorized by the Commission unless and until applicant has fully complied, within a reasonable time from the effective date of this Order, with Neb. Rev. Stat. sections 75-305 (fees), 75-307 (insurance), and 75-308 (rates) (Reissue 1996), and with the rules and regulations of the Commission, and if upon expiration of such time applicant has not complied with such terms and conditions, this Order shall, after reasonable notice to applicant, be of no further force and effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall not conduct operations until a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is issued.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the operations authorized herein shall be subject to the terms, conditions, and limitations which have been, or may hereafter be prescribed by the Commission.
