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OPINION AND FINDINGS

The application filed with the Commission on June 22, 2010, Limo 4 Hire, LLC, Lincoln, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 25, 2010. Two protests were filed by OMALINK, Inc., through its attorney, Brad Kistler, and Leisure Limousine and Sedan Service. Applicant advised this office that it would attempt to contact the protestants regarding these protests. On March 23, 2011, a letter was sent to applicant requesting the status of its application within ten (10) days of the receipt of the letter. As of April 12, 2011, there has been no communication by the applicant with this office.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before April 19, 2011, why its application should not be dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Limo 4 Hire, LLC, Lincoln, be, and it is hereby ordered to show cause why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked for failure to comply with Commission rules on or before April 19, 2011.
