OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed August 12, 2013, Party Express Bus, LLC, Omaha, seeks to change an existing operation by the transfer of stock ownership.

Notice of the application was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 13, 2013, pursuant to the rules of the Commission.

Because no protests were filed, Application B-1788 was processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of the rules of procedure of the Commission.

Party Express Bus, LLC, Omaha, is a limited liability corporation duly organized and existing under and by the virtue of the laws of the state of Nebraska, with its principal place of business being in Omaha, Nebraska. The business headquarters of Party Express Bus, LLC, will change to 4022 S. 108th Street, Omaha, Nebraska, if the transfer of the stock of Party Express Bus, LLC, is approved by the Commission. Applicant is in the business of providing transportation services by bus. The Applicant currently provides services between points in Douglas County and a 75 mile radius of Douglas County, and between points within said county on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The Applicant will continue to provide the same service.

As the matter was not protested, it proceeded on a modified basis.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. Applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the proposed extended service.
2. The proposed change of control will be consistent with the public interest and will not unduly restrict competition.
3. The certificate issued in Application B-1788 is not dormant.
4. An order should be entered in Application B-1788 authorizing Party Express Bus, LLC, Omaha, to change an existing operation by the transfer of stock ownership.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application B-1788, be, and it is hereby, granted; and that Party Express Bus, LLC, is hereby authorized to change its existing operation by the transfer of stock ownership as follows: Proposed ownership: Joel Bisgard (100%).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the operations authorized herein shall be subject to the terms, conditions, and limitations which have been, or may hereafter be prescribed by the Commission.




