OPINION AND FINDINGS

On February 17, 2011, an application was filed by Bosselman Entertainment, LLC ("Applicant"), Grand Island, seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers by bus in charter and special party between points statewide in Nebraska over irregular routes. The application was not protested. By letter dated April 7, 2011, Applicant was notified that the application would be processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure. Applicant did not complete the application process, and a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity was not issued.

On September 19, 2016, Applicant submitted notification to the Commission requesting that the application be dismissed. Notice of this request was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 21, 2016.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted and the Application No. B-1790 should be dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the request of Bosselman Entertainment, LLC, Grand Island, is hereby granted and Application No. B-1790 is hereby dismissed.
